

PIATT ROAD EXTENSION

DEL-TR99-1.79

PROJECT FACT SHEET

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Delaware County is planning to extend Piatt Road north of Cheshire Road to the new segment of Piatt Road constructed for the new Olentangy Berlin High School site located south of Berlin Station Road. The project will also upgrade the existing intersection at Cheshire Road and Piatt Road with a modern roundabout. The County has contracted with *The Mannik and Smith Group, Inc.* to design the project.

PROJECT NEED:

The extension of Piatt Road north of Cheshire Road towards Berlin Station Road is spurred by the increased traffic expected in this area. The new Olentangy Berlin High School (under construction at the north end of this project), as well as the expansion of public sewer services, has made this area of the county desirable for development. The extension of Piatt Road and the new roundabout will increase public safety and help reduce potential congestion in the area.

PROJECT LIMITS:

The proposed project will include improvements to Cheshire Road from approximately 510' east of the intersection of Piatt and Cheshire Roads to approximately 410' west of the intersection. The project limits along Piatt Road will extend from approximately 500' south of the existing intersection north to the new Olentangy Berlin High School.

PROJECT DETAILS:

- New modern roundabout at the intersection of Piatt and Cheshire Roads
- New 36' wide roadway between Cheshire Road and the new Olentangy Berlin High School
- New multi-use path at the roundabout with provisions for future paths to the north and south

PROPOSED PROJECT SCHEDULE AND CLOSURES:

Design and Engineering:	December 2016 - March 2018
Right-of-way Acquisition:	November 2017 - May 2018
Construction:	August 2018 - August 2019

It is anticipated that the intersection of Piatt Road and Cheshire Road will be closed in the summer of 2019. Please note that the above dates are approximate and are subject to change as the project progresses.

ESTIMATED PROJECT COST:

The current estimated cost of construction is approximately \$3.3 million dollars. Funding sources are to be determined.
